This is 2 day course presents the *new 2022 updated Derbyshire Language Scheme*. It is aimed at practitioners working with children or adults presenting with delayed language. It is workshop based and enables participants to gain a certificate level qualification to use the Derbyshire Language Scheme (DLS).



The DLS is a language programme used to develop receptive and expressive language skills from pre-verbal to complex stages of language development. The scheme aims to assess, profile and remediate language skills.

Learning Outcomes

- To understand the background and design features of the Derbyshire Language Scheme
- To be able to use the assessment sections of the programme at all levels
- To be able to use the assessment to design appropriate intervention using the Derbyshire Teaching sections at each level of the programme
- To be able to use the Derbyshire Language programme to set up and run group intervention sessions
- To understand how to use the programme alongside other professional colleagues
