The DLS is a language programme used to develop receptive and expressive language skills from pre-verbal to complex stages of language development. The scheme aims to assess, profile and remediate language skills.

- To understand the background and design features of the Derbyshire Language Scheme
- To be able to use the assessment sections of the programme at all levels
- To be able to use the assessment to design appropriate treatment using the Derbyshire Teaching sections at each level of the programme
- To be able to use the Derbyshire Language programme to set up and run group therapy sessions
- To understand how to use the programme alongside other professional colleagues
